- 1. Review Board Chart: Dean

 - 7-8 Stewards to be hired. Recruiting through club members and past season's steward staff.
- 3. Treasurer Update: Dean

Review of 2022 Budget proposal summary:

- 3.5% increase for memberships and wages,
- \$50.000 target profit.
- \$29,000 members 2021 Covid rebate.
- increase pro's court fees to \$16,
- \$26,000 sprinkler system.
- Dean will work with Patrick to streamline the payment system, including shifting payments to Court Reserve.

- 4. Programs and Revenue Sharing Model Values
 - Court fees for lessons provided by Rachel and Chris were paid direct to club at \$15.00 per hour.
 - Need to post 2022 programming by Halliday Tennis need to include in communique
 - Chris requires 2 courts for July and August
 - How do we track players number of users?
 - Question raised about the increase in fees for programming and pro fees
 - John to follow up with Chris regarding price point for the programs / price increase for programs
 - Is there a trade off? Cap on number of hours per week for lessons i.e., trying to find balance in court time.
 - Registration process and financials direct to Dean
 - Is Chris using ETC insurance?
 - Question around branding ETC or Halliday Tennis?
 - Discussion around noon time slot suggest that Chris have 2 courts from 1 to 4.
